Compound: Clean-X, Clean Shield, Sani-Shield, Clean & Shield,
and Rain Clear Batch H-97

Acute Eye Irritation (OPPTS 870.2400) Toxicity Category III. The compound produced minimal ocular irritation and would not be considered to be an eye irritant.

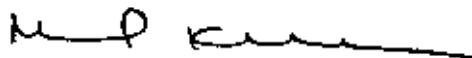
Acute Skin Irritation (OPPTS 870.2500) Toxicity Category IV. The compound produced minimal dermal irritation and would not be considered to be a skin irritant.

Acute Oral Toxicity (OPPTS 870.1100) Toxicity Category IV. The compound produced no mortality or adverse health effects at an oral dose of 5.0 g/kg. The compound is not toxic by oral ingestion.

Acute Dermal Toxicity (OPPTS 870.1200) Toxicity Category III. The compound produced no mortality or adverse health effects at a dermal dose of 2.0g/kg. The compound would not be considered toxic by dermal exposure.

Skin Sensitization (OPPTS 870.2600) Toxicity Category IV. The compound produced no dermal sensitization responses after three topical inductions and a topical challenge. The compound would not be considered a dermal sensitizer.

Acute Inhalation Toxicity (OPPTS 870.1300) Toxicity Category III. The compound produced no mortality or adverse health effects at an atmospheric concentration of 2.69 mg/liter of air (2,690 ppm) after a four hour exposure. The compound would not be considered toxic by inhalation exposure.



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
